

Western Massachusetts Inter - Patrol Competition

First Event

First Aid Belt Relay

All Five Team Members Participate

Object: Ski a giant slalom course to designated relay box. Hand first-aid belt to team mate who skis course to next designated relay box and so on till last member finishes.

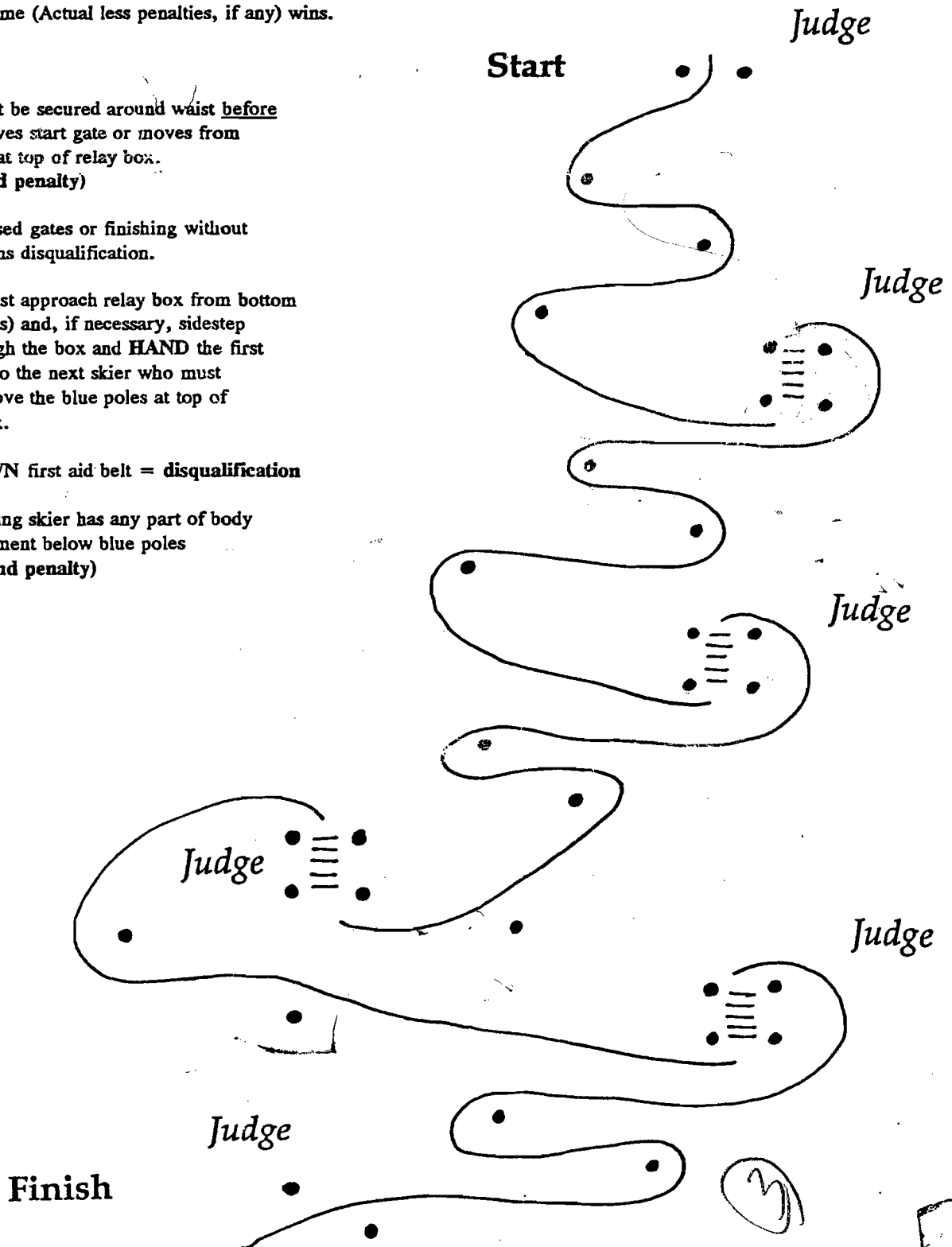
Score: Fastest time (Actual less penalties, if any) wins.

Rules:

1. Belt must be secured around waist before skier leaves start gate or moves from position at top of relay box. (5 second penalty)
2. Any missed gates or finishing without belt means disqualification.
3. Skier must approach relay box from bottom (red poles) and, if necessary, sidestep up through the box and **HAND** the first aid belt to the next skier who must stand above the blue poles at top of relay box.

THROWN first aid belt = disqualification

If receiving skier has any part of body or equipment below blue poles (10 second penalty)

Third Event

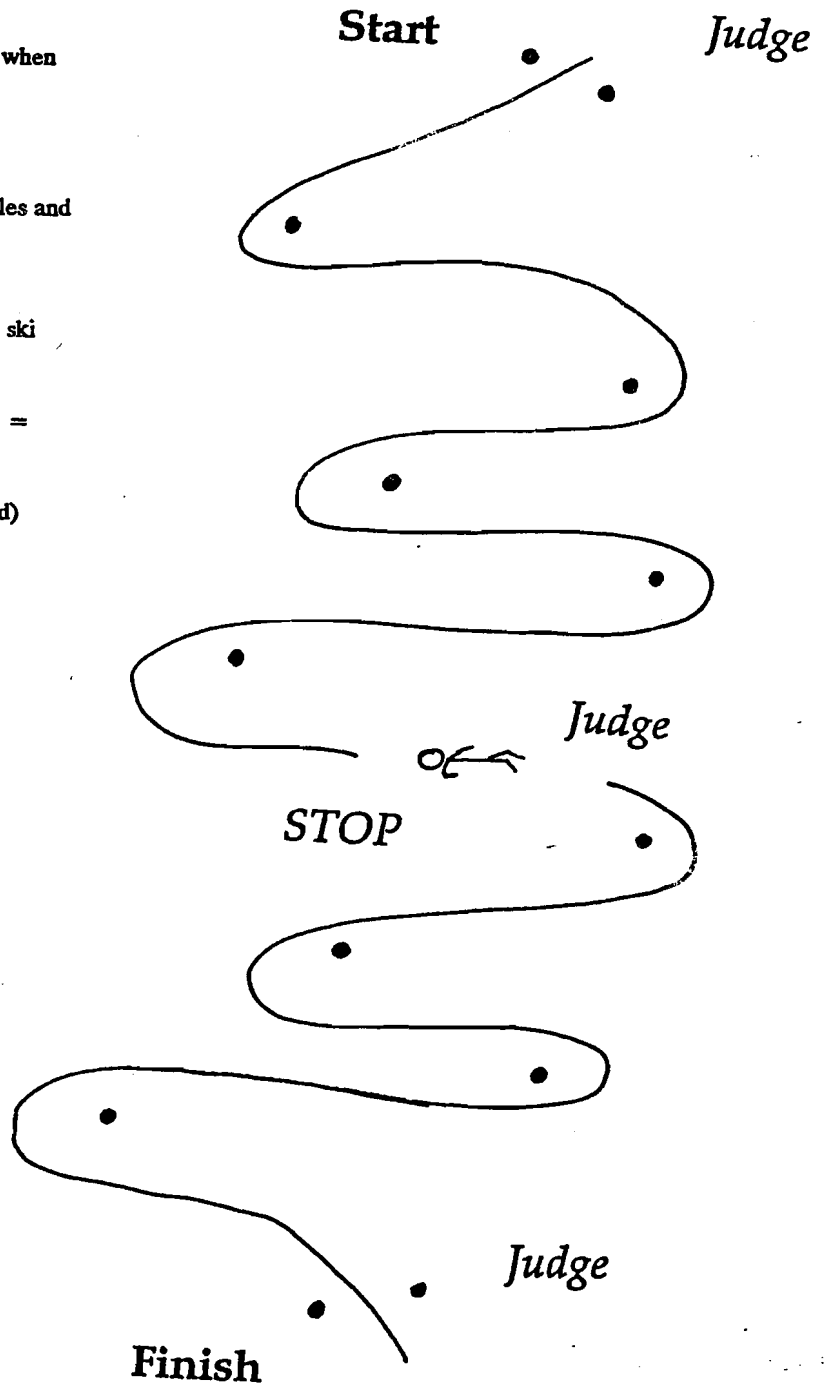
Mannequin Pick-up *ANY (and Only) THREE Team Members Participate*

Object: Ski a predetermined course. Stop at location of "injured skier". Load "injured skier" head up or head down depending upon injury described by judge. Secure "injured skier" in toboggan and ski remainder of course.

Score: Fastest time wins. Clock is started by first team-member through start gate and stopped when last member goes through finish.

Rules:

1. One team-member must be in toboggan handles and another team-member must be on tailrope.
Failure = disqualification
2. Third team-member may ride in toboggan or ski separately. This is team's choice.
3. Inappropriate loading of injured skier in sled = **10 Second Penalty**
4. Minimum of two regulation (Factory installed) straps must hold "injured skier" in toboggan when crossing finish line.
Failure = 15 second penalty
5. Missed gates = **disqualification**
6. Handles locked or unlocked - team's choice.

Fourth Event

Obstacle Course *All five team members participate*

Object: Each team member skis designated course performing tasks indicated by each location.

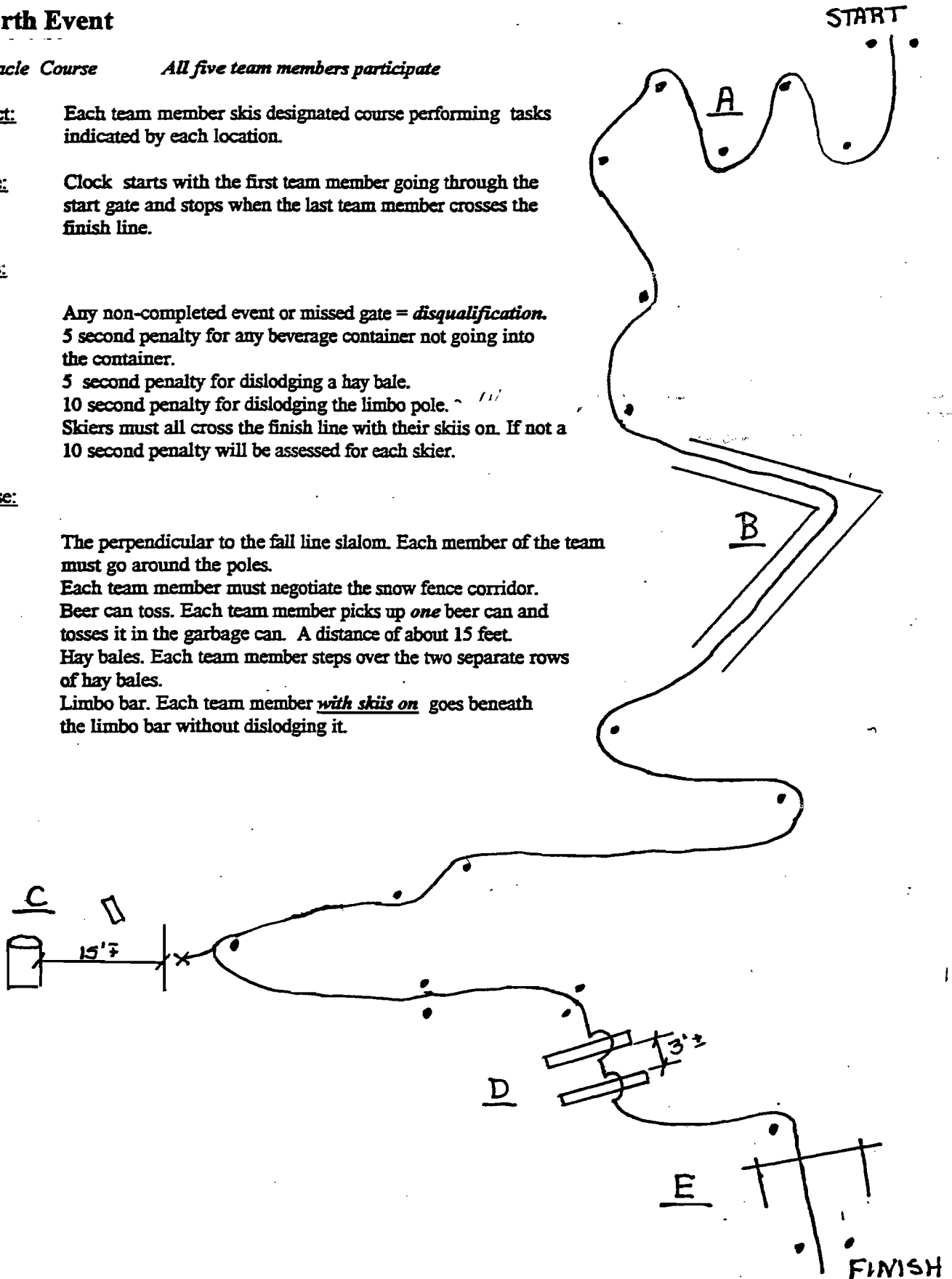
Score: Clock starts with the first team member going through the start gate and stops when the last team member crosses the finish line.

Rules:

1. Any non-completed event or missed gate = *disqualification*.
2. 5 second penalty for any beverage container not going into the container.
3. 5 second penalty for dislodging a hay bale.
4. 10 second penalty for dislodging the limbo pole.
5. Skiers must all cross the finish line with their skis on. If not a 10 second penalty will be assessed for each skier.

Course:

- A. The perpendicular to the fall line slalom. Each member of the team must go around the poles.
- B. Each team member must negotiate the snow fence corridor.
- C. Beer can toss. Each team member picks up *one* beer can and tosses it in the garbage can. A distance of about 15 feet.
- D. Hay bales. Each team member steps over the two separate rows of hay bales.
- E. Limbo bar. Each team member with skis on goes beneath the limbo bar without dislodging it.

Fifth Event

Scavenger Hunt

All Five Team Members Participate

Object: Help skier find lost articles. All five team members attempt to find ten "lost articles" within two designated search areas not visible from start gate.

Score: Clock starts with first team-member going through start gate and stops when last team-member crosses finish line. Ten seconds will be subtracted from total time for each "lost article" found and placed in "box" (squared off by orange and black bamboo poles lying flat on snow to form box) located immediately below each search area. Fastest time wins.

Rules: Only one. Teams producing more that ten lost articles will forfeit all time saved by finding the original ten.
